

Opera Security Settings

Overview

The information below should resolve any security issues on our website when using the Opera browser, version 9 or later.

'Security Settings' is a general term for the rules your browser follows when deciding what it will allow websites to do. These are in place to prevent malicious sites from making changes to your PC without your knowledge.

Most major websites including bet365 adhere to the default settings for your browser. However, if your security settings are set higher than the default, they may prevent certain web pages from displaying correctly, or possibly prevent them from displaying at all.

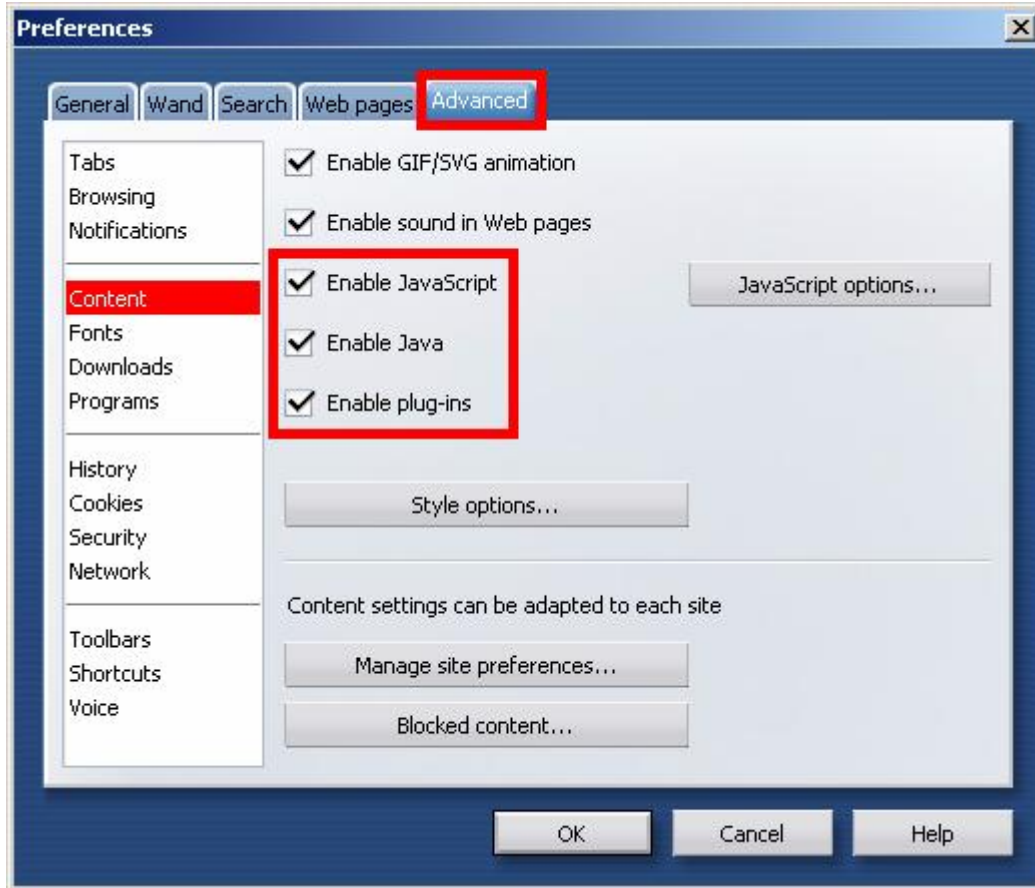

- 1) Open the Opera browser.
- 2) Click on 'Tools' on the top bar, then 'Preferences...':

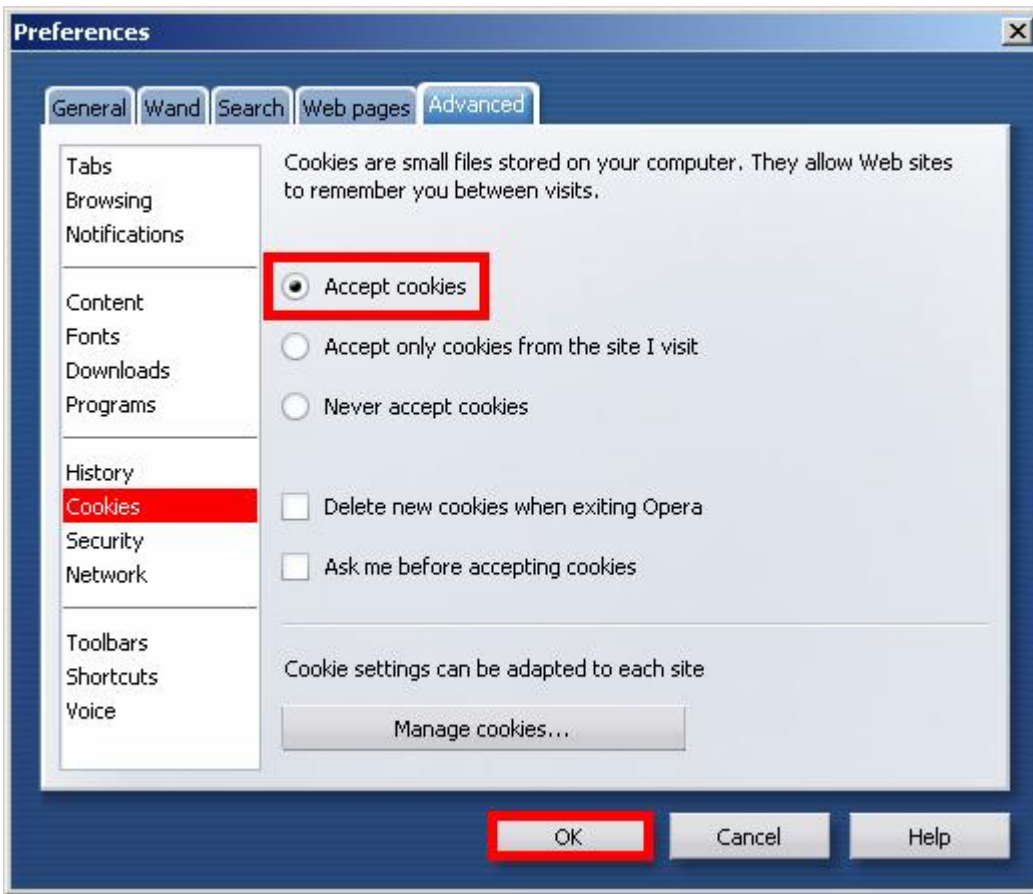


3) Select the 'Advanced' tab then the 'Content' option from the menu on the left hand side and ensure the following options are ticked:

- 'Enable Java'
- 'Enable plug-ins'
